

Jason J. McGuire

Biography

Jason J. McGuire serves as Executive Director of New Yorkers for Constitutional Freedoms (NYCF) and as President of NYCF's affiliated educational arm, New Yorker's Family Research Foundation. Mr. McGuire has been on staff with NYCF since 2007, and has been an integral part of the continued growth and impact of the organization since that time.

Mr. McGuire is inspired by the mission of New Yorkers for Constitutional Freedoms: To influence legislation and legislators for the Lord Jesus Christ. He and his staff create and implement innovative lobbying, public relations, organizing, and advertising strategies that help to fulfill that mission. Mr. McGuire is a passionate defender of Christian principles like the sanctity of life, the sacredness of marriage, the centrality of religious freedom, and the need for a more just and merciful society, and he fervently believes that these principles can only be lived out if the hearts of men and women turn to God. A gifted and accomplished public speaker, Mr. McGuire preaches and teaches at churches and conferences across the state and the nation; also, he is frequently called upon by state and national media outlets for his expertise regarding New York state government and public policy.

Mr. McGuire's radio broadcasts can be heard on Christian stations throughout New York, and his weekly *Albany Update* informs tens of thousands of grassroots Christian activists. Both locally and nationally, he is widely recognized as a key leader in the pro-life and pro-family movements.

As recognition of his efforts to defend the sanctity of human life, McGuire was the 2013 Leo Holmsten Human Life Award recipient. His efforts to advance conservative values have been recognized by the New York State Conservative Party as well. In 2014, Rev. McGuire was presented with the J. Daniel Mahoney Award.

Mr. McGuire attended Practical Bible Training School (now known as Davis College) in Johnson City, New York, and holds a Bachelor of Theology Degree from Andersonville Theological Seminary, Camilla, Georgia. Prior to his employment with NYCF, he served as pastor of the Ingleside Christian Church (Naples, NY). Today Mr. McGuire and his family reside in the Rochester region. He and his wife, Lorenne, were married in 1996 and have been blessed with four children.
