



**Bill S.5883 (Bonacic)/A.8101 (Pretlow)**  
**Upstate New York Gaming Development Act of 2013**  
**New York State Senate, June 21, 2013**

This law (a) provides a legal framework for casino gambling in the event that the proposed casino gambling amendment to the State Constitution is approved by voters; and (b) indicates that if the amendment is voted down, the state may license an unlimited number of stand-alone video lottery terminals in upstate New York. On June 21, 2013, this bill passed the New York State Senate by a vote of 48-11; it was signed into law on July 30, 2013.
