



## Ban on Reparative Therapy for Minors - A.6983-B (Glick)

### New York State Assembly, June 16, 2014

The New York State Assembly passed Bill A.6983-B, which would ban reparative therapy for minors, by a vote of 105-28. This bill would make it unlawful for mental health professionals to assist minors in overcoming unwanted same-sex (homosexual) attraction. This bill—also known as the Counselor Coercion bill—has not passed the State Senate to date.
